

BURSARY FOR DRIVER'S EDUCATION PROGRAM

This Children's Aid Foundation Driver's Education Program Bursary has been developed to assist youth with current involvement with The Children's Aid Society of the District of Thunder Bay, to achieve independence skills and career goals.

The bursary is offered to young people who wish to obtain a driver's license and complete a Driver's Education Program. This bursary will provide up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) towards the cost of a Driver's Education Program.

The bursary recipient(s) will be selected by the Children's Aid Foundation Bursary Committee. If selected to receive the bursary, the applicant must complete a driver's education course by December 31, 2026.

ELIGIBILITY

This bursary is available to:

- Persons who are 16 years of age or older who have Child in Extended Society Care status, are on a Voluntary Youth Service Agreement (VYSA), or had Child in Extended Society Care status with the Children's Aid Society of the District of Thunder Bay on their 18th Birthday and are currently on a Ready, Set, Go Agreement (RSG); or
- Persons who are 16 years of age or older who are currently involved with the Agency on a Kinship Service or Ongoing Protection Capacity
